Does the bible endorse slavery?

Genesis 1:27

27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them

Genesis 15:13-14

13 Then the LORD said to Abram, "Know for certain that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not their own, and they will be enslaved and mistreated four hundred years. 14 But I will judge the nation they serve as slaves, and afterward they will depart with many possessions. c

Genesis 9:25

When Noah awoke from his wine, he knew what his youngest son had done to him.

25 So he said, "Cursed be Canaan; A servant of servants He shall be to his brothers."

Exodus 3:1-15:27

7 The LORD said, "I have surely seen the affliction of My people who are in Egypt, and have given heed to their cry because of their taskmasters, for I am aware of their sufferings. 8 "So I have come down to deliver them from the power of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and spacious land, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanite and the Hittite and the Amorite and the Perizzite and the Hivite and the Jebusite. 9 "Now, behold, the cry of the sons of Israel has come to Me; furthermore, I have seen the oppression with which the Egyptians are oppressing them.

Exodus 20:10

9 Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, 10 but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates.

Exodus 21:1-36

1 "Now these are the rules that you shall set before them. 2 When you buy a Hebrew slave, a he shall serve six years, and in the seventh he shall go out free, for nothing. 3 If he comes in single, he shall go out single; if he comes in married, then his wife shall go out with him. 4 If his master gives him a wife and she bears him sons or daughters, the wife and her children shall be her master's, and he shall go out alone. 5 But if the slave plainly says, 'I love my master, my wife, and my children; I will not go out free,' 6 then his master shall bring him to God, and he shall bring him to the door or the doorpost. And his master shall bore his ear through with an awl, and he shall be his slave forever.

7 "When a man sells his daughter as a slave, she shall not go out as the male slaves do. 8 If she does not please her master, who has designated her b for himself, then he shall let her be redeemed. He shall have no right to sell her to a foreign people, since he has broken faith with her. 9 If he designates her for his son, he shall deal with her as with a daughter. 10 If he takes another wife to himself, he shall not diminish her food, her clothing, or her marital rights. 11 And if he does not do these three things for her, she shall go out for nothing, without payment of money.

16 "Whoever steals a man and sells him, and anyone found in possession of him, shall be put to death.

20 "When a man strikes his slave, male or female, with a rod and the slave dies under his hand, he shall be avenged. 21 But if the slave survives a day or two, he is not to be avenged, for the slave is his money.

26 "When a man strikes the eye of his slave, male or female, and destroys it, he shall let the slave go free because of his eye. 27 If he knocks out the tooth of his slave, male or female, he shall let the slave go free because of his tooth.

1 Corinthians 7:21-24

21Were you a bondservant^d when called? Do not be concerned about it. (But if you can gain your freedom, avail yourself of the opportunity.) **22**For he who was called in the Lord as a bondservant is a freedman of the Lord. Likewise he who was free when called is a bondservant of Christ. **23**You were bought with a price; do not become bondservants of men. **24**So, brothers,^e in whatever condition each was called, there let him remain with God.

1 Corinthians 12:13

12For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. **13**For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves^d or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.

Galatians 3:28-29

[27](#)For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. [28](#)There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave^a nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. [29](#)And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.

Galatians 5:1

Ephesians 6:5-9

[5](#)Bondservants,^a obey your earthly masters^b with fear and trembling, with a sincere heart, as you would Christ, [6](#)not by the way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart, [7](#)rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man, [8](#)knowing that whatever good anyone does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether he is a bondservant or is free. [9](#)Masters, do the same to them, and stop your threatening, knowing that he who is both their Master^c and yours is in heaven, and that there is no partiality with him.

Colossians 3:9-12

[9](#)Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self^d with its practices [10](#)and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator. [11](#)Here there is not Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave,^e free; but Christ is all, and in all.

Colossians 3:22-25

[22](#)Slaves, in all things obey those who are your masters on earth, not with external service, as those who *merely* please men, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord. [23](#)Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men, [24](#)knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance. It is the Lord Christ whom you serve. [25](#)For he who does wrong will receive the consequences of the wrong which he has done, and that without partiality.

Colossians 4:1

[1](#)Masters, treat your bondservants^a justly and fairly, knowing that you also have a Master in heaven.

1 Timothy 1:8-10

[8](#)Now we know that the law is good, if one uses it lawfully, [9](#)understanding this, that the law is not laid down for the just but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and sinners, for the unholy and profane, for those who strike their fathers and mothers, for murderers, [10](#)the sexually immoral, men who practice homosexuality, enslavers,^b liars, perjurers, and whatever else is contrary to sound^c doctrine, [11](#)in accordance with the gospel of the glory of the blessed God with which I have been entrusted.

1 Timothy 6:1-2

[1](#)Let all who are under a yoke as bondservants^a regard their own masters as worthy of all honor, so that the name of God and the teaching may not be reviled. [2](#)Those who have believing masters must not be disrespectful on the ground that they are brothers; rather they must serve all the better since those who benefit by their good service are believers and beloved.

Titus 2:9-11

[9](#)Bondservants^b are to be submissive to their own masters in everything; they are to be well-pleasing, not argumentative, [10](#)not pilfering, but showing all good faith, so that in everything they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior.

[11](#)For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people,

Philemon 1:16

[15](#)For this perhaps is why he was parted from you for a while, that you might have him back forever, [16](#)no longer as a bondservant^e but more than a bondservant, as a beloved brother—especially to me, but how much more to you, both in the flesh and in the Lord.

1 Peter 2:16-21

[16](#)Live as people who are free, not using your freedom as a cover-up for evil, but living as servants^d of God. [17](#)Honor everyone. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the emperor.

[18](#)Servants, be subject to your masters with all respect, not only to the good and gentle but also to the unjust. [19](#)For this is a gracious thing, when, mindful of God, one endures sorrows while suffering unjustly. [20](#)For what credit is it if, when you sin and are beaten for it, you endure? But if when you do good and suffer for it you endure, this is a gracious thing in the sight of God. [21](#)For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you might follow in his steps
