## Study 10 – Belief, Obedience and God's Witness: – 1 John 5:1–121

- 1. Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves Him who begot also loves him who is begotten of Him.
- 2. By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and keep His commandments.
- 3. For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.
- 4. For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—[a]our faith.
- 5. Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?
- 6. This is He who came by water and blood—Jesus Christ; not only by water, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who bears witness, because the Spirit is truth.
- 7. For there are three that bear witness [b]in heaven: the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one.
- 8. And there are three that bear witness on earth: the Spirit, the water, and the blood; and these three agree as one.
- 9. If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater; for this is the witness of [c]God which He has testified of His Son.
- 10. He who believes in the Son of God has the witness in himself; he who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed the testimony that God has given of His Son.
- 11. And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son.
- 12. He who has the Son has [d]life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

- C. How is a person's love for God expressed? Which, if any, of God's commands seems to be grievous, burdensome or difficult to obey? Why? v. 3.
- D. What does John mean by someone "overcoming the world"? Explain how "faith" enables one to overcome the world. v. 4.
- E. What is the faith the overcomes the world? Explain how this faith is essential in overcoming the world. v. 5.
- F. What is significant about Jesus's baptism and death establishing His identity? Why did He submit to baptism? Why was His death necessary? What is the Spirit's role? v. 6.
- G. How would you define/describe a witness? Who are the witnesses in v. 7 and in v. 8? What is their testimony? v. 7-8.
- H. How would you summarize God's testimony through His witnesses concerning His Son? Compare the strength of it to the witness and testimony of men. v. 9
- I. Why are you willing to believe God's testimony according to John? Why do think so many other are not? v. 9
- J. What witness or testimony does John say believers have within them? What is the effect of not believing God's testimony? v. 10.
- K. What is the meaning and purpose of God's testimony? What is the means through which the meaning and purpose of God's testimony is realized? v. 11
- L. How can or does a person "have the Son"? Having the Son also means having "the life". What is "the life" and how is different from any other life? v. 12
